The 14^o Ring is the Scottish Rite symbol that represents the sword and armour of our ancient brethren and as clearly marks the profession of Knighthood as did those pieces of equipment. The ring is to be honourably worn throughout life, and at death, as was the custom then, it is to be given to one most dear to its original owner in the hope and belief that it will be kept spotless and inviolate.

This is a flat gold band upon which has been superimposed an equilateral triangle within which is the Hebrew letter Yod. The motto of this Degree is "Virtus, junxit mors non separabit"; virtue has united; death shall not separate.

As members of the Rite circulate in the course of business or pleasure across the Dominion, their principal mode of casual recognition is the 'Ring', symbol of Eternity and unbroken friendship, the visible mark of a mutual compact. Its wearers should always greet each other with the fraternal interest and mutual regard which the fellowship of kindred interest and obligations should inspire.
